



ATTEMPTED RAPE OR ATTEMPTED MURDER?

“Forced Entry” - #033 – When an attempted rapist is shot on a Naval base, NCIS Special Agents are brought on the case to investigate whether it was self-defense or attempted murder, on NCIS Tuesday, December 7, 2004 (8:00-9:00 PM, ET/PT) on CBS.
